Zdenka Janeković-Römer (b. 1961) graduated in the disciplines History and Literature at the University of Zagreb (MA 1991, PhD 1997). In the years 1999-2004 she was Assoc. Professor of Medieval History of Croatia, Latin Palaeography, Historiography and Theory of History and Head of the Postgraduate Studies Programme at the Department of History, both Univ. of Zagreb. Since 2004 she is a senior researcher at the Institute for Historical Sciences of the Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts, Dubrovnik. She teaches doctorate level courses at the Universities of Dubrovnik and Zagreb as well as at the Croatian Catholic University in Zagreb.

The principal objects of her study are nobility, family, social practices and culture in late medieval and early modern Dubrovnik and Dalmatia. She has also been working on historiography and theoretical dimensions of history. More recently, she has turned her attention to the cultural, religious and social changes of the late medieval and early modern Croatian history.

In 2000 Zdenka Janeković Römer was honoured for her book *Okvir slobode. Dubrovačka vlastela između srednjovjekovlja i humanizma* (1999) with the annual reward "Oton Kučera" by Matica Hrvatska / Matrix croatica for the best scholarly work. In 2008 she received the Croatian National Science Award for her book *Maruša ili suđenje ljubavi. Bračno-ljubavna priča iz srednjovjekovnog Dubrovnika* (2007) and in 2010 the Award of Croatian Academy of Sciences and Arts for her edition of Benedikt Kotrulj, *Libro del arte dela mercatura. Knjiga o vještini trgovanja* (2009).
